## Minutes

1. Follow up
  - a. Roses

- i. Nothing has happened as such
    - ii. There may be a meeting next week? It was scheduled ages ago but no communication has happened so who knows?
  - b. We successfully did a GDPR by yeeting the mailing list
    - i. We're back to a similar number of mailing list recipients as before
  - c. The Moll Inquiry to investigate GDPR-gate
    - i. AC and LM have made a calendar thingy
    - ii. It works but review needs to happen
  - d. Knowledge Base Working Group
    - i. A MediaWiki has been set up
    - ii. Skins are being worked on
    - iii. Content to be decided
  - e. AH is chasing Morgan Stanley and talk people about monies
- 2. Film night
  - a. *Unenthusiastic cheer*
  - b. Sam Hand used to run it
  - c. Sam Hand died and went to the great Cambridge in the Sky
  - d. We need someone to take it over
  - e. CW and EH have shown interest but can't because they're busy on Fridays
  - f. There exist freshers, Daniel and Tara, who are willing.
- 3. ShockSoc email
  - a. ShockSoc are interested in setting up an intersociety Minecraft server
  - b. Potentially involved: FragSoc
  - c. We would like to share administration
    - i. Might be "equal but not identical" (e.g. we do hardware but ShockSoc manage Minecraft)
  - d. University firewall means that the server wouldn't currently be accessible off-campus without VPN
    - i. We can ask ITS
    - ii. AB says they'll probably say no, only precedent is HTTP(S) for us/YSTV/URY
    - iii. The alternative is to host off-campus
  - e. This is a shared venture but we don't have a shared domain name
    - i. Possible to have both minecraft.(hacksoc.org|shocksoc.tld)
    - ii. Better to have a shared one
    - iii. JA is reticent to pay for recurring costs
    - iv. This can all be figured out down the line
- 4. Spending monies (on the boardgames)
  - a. AH says we have too much money
  - b. Money can be exchanged for goods, services, and boardgames
  - c. Proposals
    - i. Captain Sonar - ~£32
    - ii. Betrayal at House on the Hill - ~£36
    - iii. Carcassonne w/ River Expansion + another - ~£40
    - iv. Risk - ~£23
    - v. Love Letter - ~£10

- vi. Scrabble - ~£15
- vii. Uno - ~£5
- d. Monopoly is banned
- e. Pass upto £200 for boardgames (following the above plan)
  - Vote: 8 for, 0 against, 0 abstain
- f. Where to buy from?
  - i. Preferably Travelling Man
  - ii. Amazon if TM is significantly more expensive

    - i. Somewhere that actually does a good job of meeting dietary requirements and preferences please
    - ii. We should do a survey to figure out who wants to come and their requirements
    - iii. Consider price but York is York
  - b. Preferably in week 9 or 10, not Friday or wk 10 Thurs
- 6. BCS Lovelace workshop
  - a. BCS Lovelace is a conference for CS undergrad women
    - i. One day conference with talks and poster competition
    - ii. Travel + accommodation are paid for for anyone doing poster competition (department probably willing to fund anyone who doesn't get shortlisted)
    - iii. Conference is in Glasgow on 8th
    - iv. Abstract submissions now open
  - b. CW would like to encourage people to get involved by running a workshop to help with writing abstracts
  - c. Would be nice to work with other departmental entities who have an interest (e.g. Helen Petrie, Nic Peard, Chloe (?), Luisa Kettlewell)
  - d. Could ask the department to organise some catering for such a workshop?
- 7. GIAG
  - a. YUSU wants societies to run events for people who aren't members
  - b. We did this last year with the first Python workshop
  - c. We would like to do it again
  - d. When?
    - i. "GIAG week" is Spr/2 but we can do it another time
    - ii. A Wednesday afternoon is the best
  - e. Would be nice to have at least 5 PTAs
  - f. 3rd-years might or might not be available to run it, 2nd-years could if needed
- 8. "Continuity"
  - a. When next committee happens, everyone but OMs probably needs to do handover
